VIRTUAL PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- We will not record any of our zoom events. We ask that participants refrain from recording the events as well.
- We strive to offer access to safe, welcoming virtual zoom rooms for everyone's participation. We ask that all parties involved in the sessions are respectful while participating; including taking turns; being polite and inclusive; attentive and collaborative; discreet and non-judgmental, etc.
- Just like in our drop-in programs, please feel free to sign-on or leave at any time.
- Your ID access to EYET Zoom Rooms is only for personal use of the registered participant/s. Please do not share your ID access information with anyone else.
- If you have any questions and we are unable to get to them during the session, please leave your question in the chat window of the event and someone will follow up with you directly to get you the information you requested.
- Participant's information is never disclosed to anyone else, except personnel handling the EYET data system and staff who may be contacted to prepare a response.
- As a participant, I agree to have my screen name matching my registration form name to allow for a safer zoom room participation. I understand that by not providing a matching screen name, I will not be allowed to remain in the zoom room.
