Housing Help Services Certificate - Winter Session

The Housing Help Services Certificate (HHSC) is a comprehensive professional development certificate that provides skills and competencies to housing workers in order to serve clients more effectively within the housing and homelessness sector. Staff completing this certificate will benefit from up-to-date training in this specialized, housing-focused, area of service delivery.

Consists of six days of training, one day per week, 9:30am - 3:30pm
Costs \$450 per participant to register
Training is delivered at locations in Toronto
